

2020 SUMMER LEAGUE PLAY

The current Franchises are: Buschslappers, Pitching Pandas, and Team Ramrod

League Play will be under the 2019 Adopted Rules of The YiSH unless otherwise noted.

The Franchise Owner donation for a season is \$100.00.

- You may own a team and NOT declare yourself as eligible for the draft(s).
- Application deadline to be considered as an Expansion Franchise ends ~~July~~ 1st at 12:01 A.M.

The current Franchise Owners determined a Team Salary Cap value, duration of a season, and established the schedule as beginning on ~~July 10th~~ at 7:00 P.M., lasting eight weeks, and ending on Friday, ~~August 28th~~, 2020.

An individual can declare his or her eligibility to enter the draft or commit to the new season HERE (<https://www.theyish.com/summer-league/>)

- In conjunction with the player eligibility declaration, a player will have to designate a projected participation percentage (100%-75%-50%-25%) so Owners will have that key detail in the Primary Draft when considering the player contract value, then in the Supplemental Draft as a tax risk assessment.
- The Player Declaration deadline is ~~Wednesday, July 1st, 2020~~ with Player Draft to be held on or before ~~Monday, July 6th~~, 2020.

A Primary Draft will be held where owners compete for declared players via a bidding process, and thereby establish the player contract value.

- Each Franchise Owner starts 1,000 credits, then subtracts the values of the current player contracts with the championship team from the prior year receiving a bonus of 250 credits

Owners may elect to hold a Supplemental Draft, again establishing a salary cap for it, which will then be added to the Primary Draft cap for a Final Salary cap.

- After the conclusion of the Supplemental Draft, each Owner shall have the same number of players on his or her roster. If this is not mathematically possible, each Franchise Owner may be forced designate 'Protected Players' and 'Unprotected Players' will be released as 'Free Agents' for a Re-Draft with the respective player values of the 'Unprotected Players' being credited back to the given Franchise Owner.
- A Salary Cap Tax is in effect to curb against players holding out for the Supplemental Draft.

Player Contracts, Trades & Releases

- The period of a player contract is two years, from either draft selection or contract renewal.
- Franchise Owners can negotiate player trades or release players to help fill a need in his or her roster and/or for the purpose of gaining salary cap room.
 - Pre-season Trades and Releases must occur one hour prior to Draft selection for the season.
 - A mid-season trade deadline may be established by the Franchise Owners.
 - If a player is traded, he or she is under contract with the new owner for the time remaining on his or her contract.
 - If a player is released or the contract with that player has expired, the Franchise Owner who released the player or wishes to renew the contract, can retain that player, with exclusive 1st option. However, it will cost 125% of player's most recent draft or player contract value. If neither occurs, the player is considered a Free Agent and re-drafted.

The Franchise Owner of the team who is crowned Champion will retain 50% of the combined league earnings while 50% will be retained by the host site.
